Flower Arranging

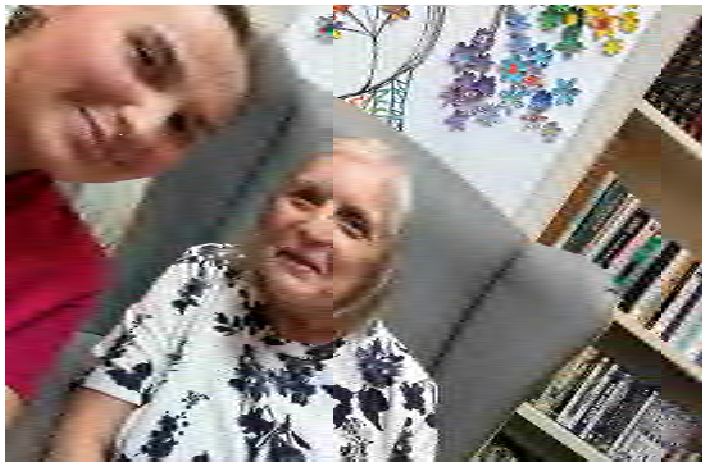
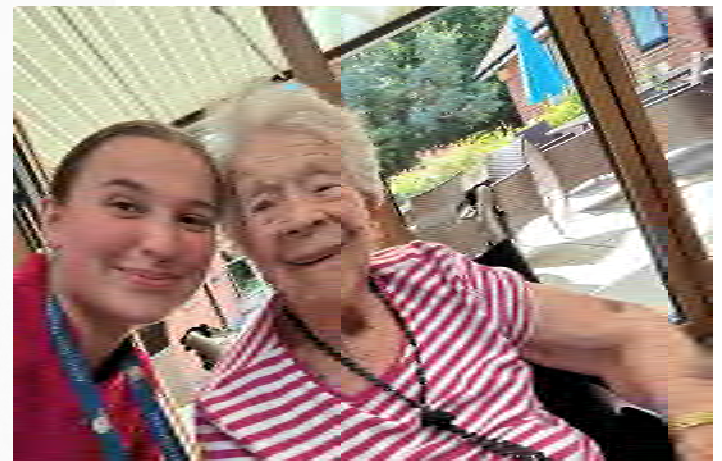
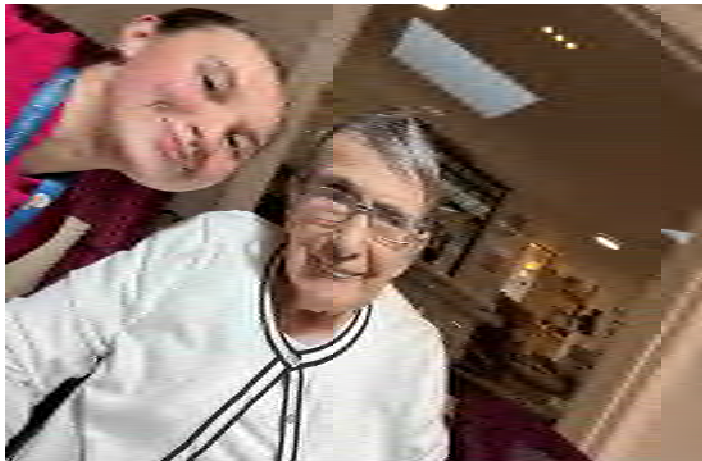

Woody's cafe

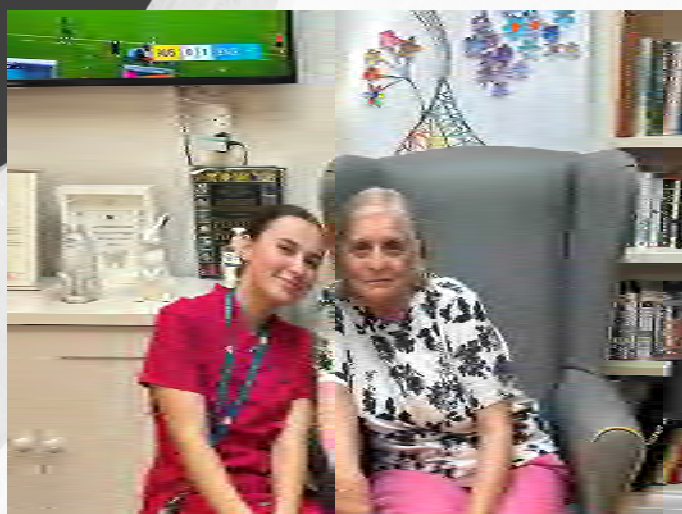


Here's our residents' enjoying another visit to the very friendly Woody's Café for a lovely cuppa and a piece of cake!
