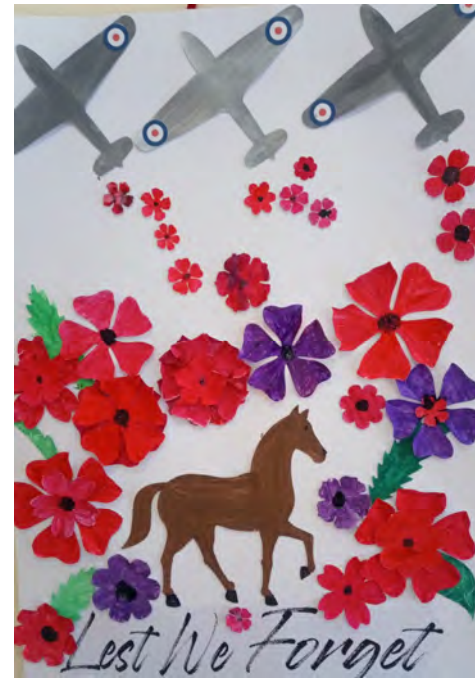

Residents had a lovely morning painting poppies with Creative Mojo. The finished pieces of artwork were used to make this wonderful picture for our wall.







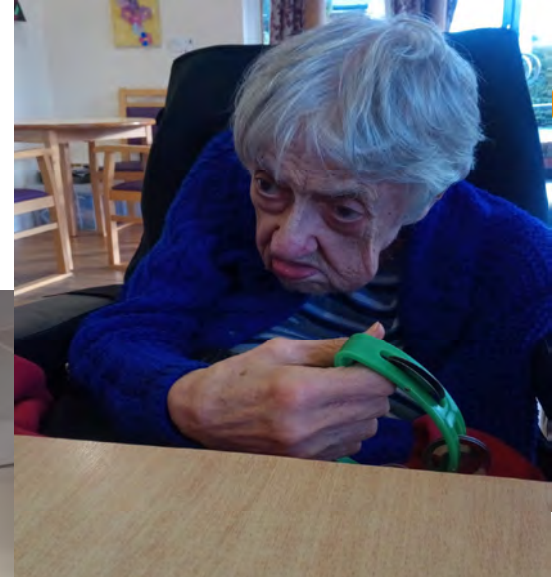

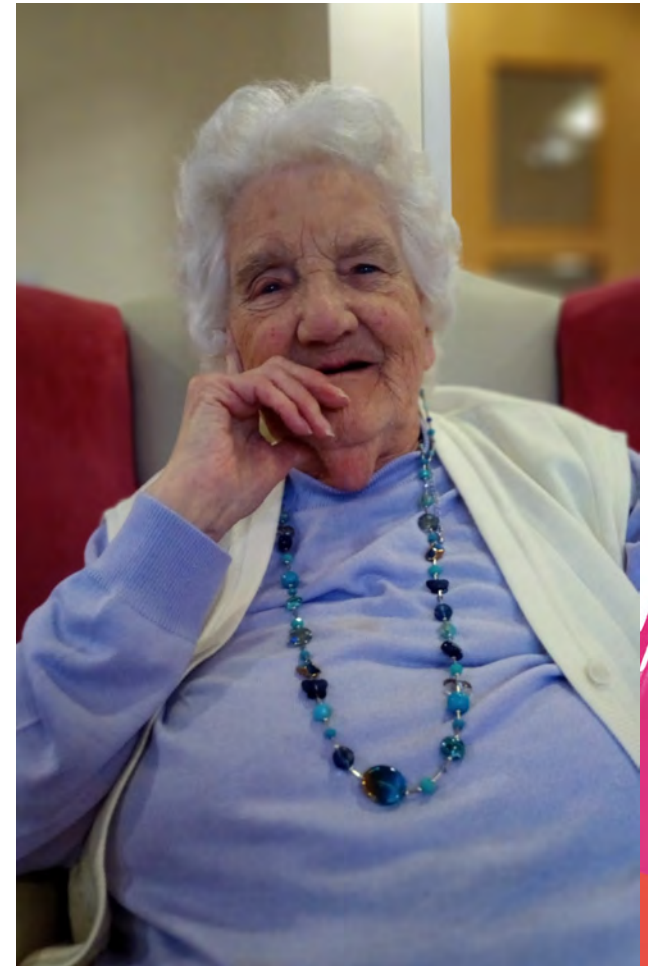

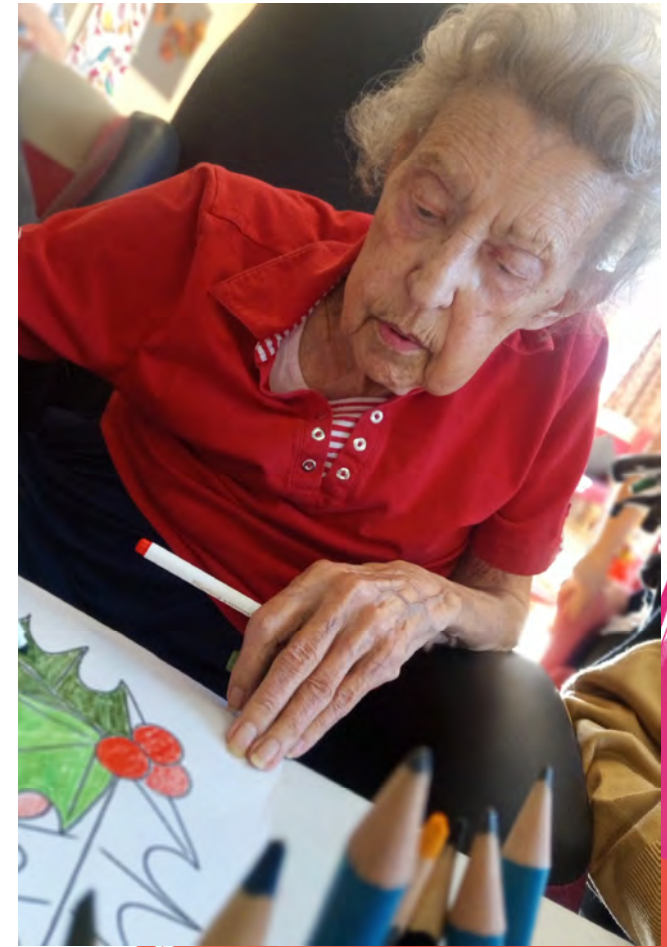


Creative Mojo
