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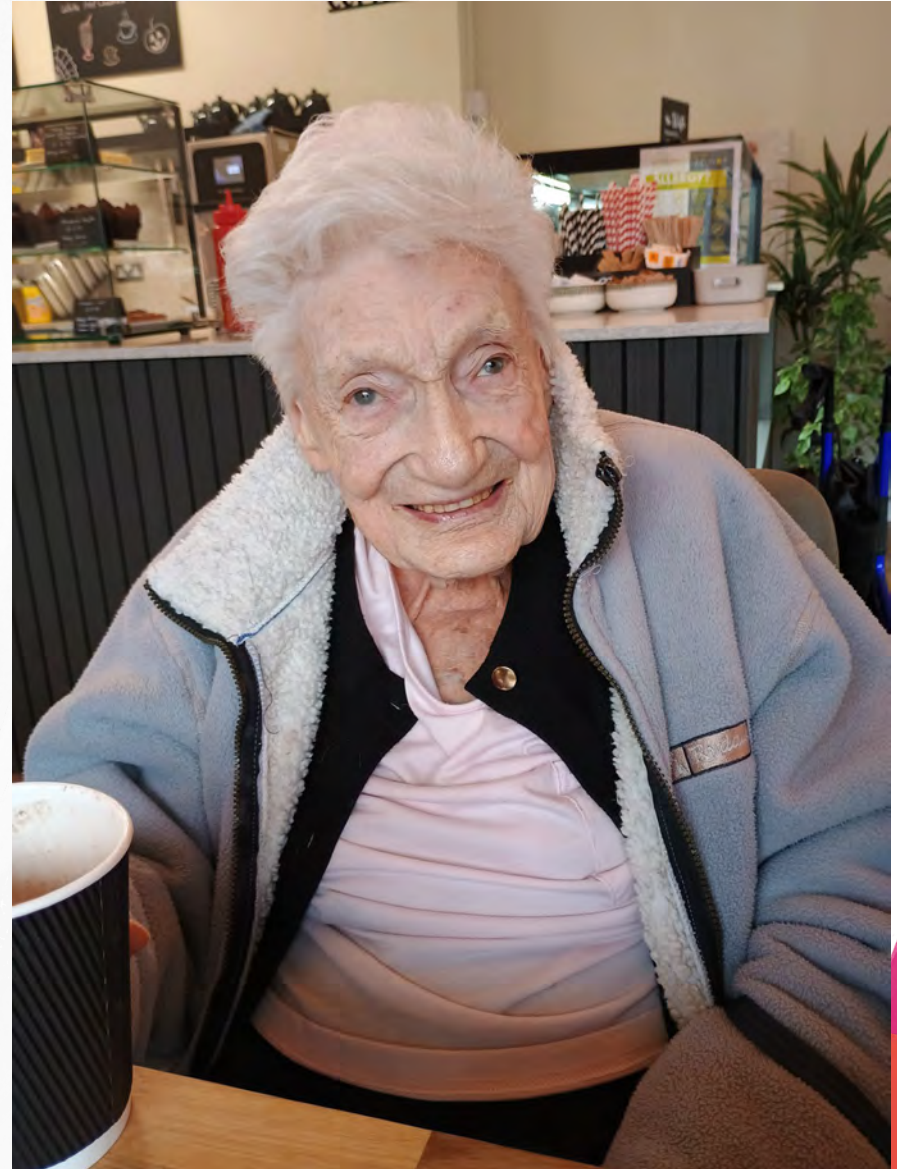
What another amazing month we've had from trips out, wonderful entertainment and another visit from Mabel our therapy dog! Lots of poppy making and selfie photos too!
