Mary took a church service for the other residents and staff.

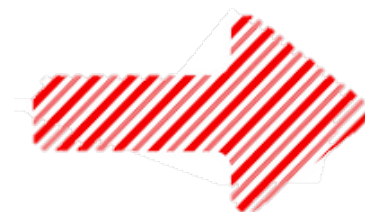
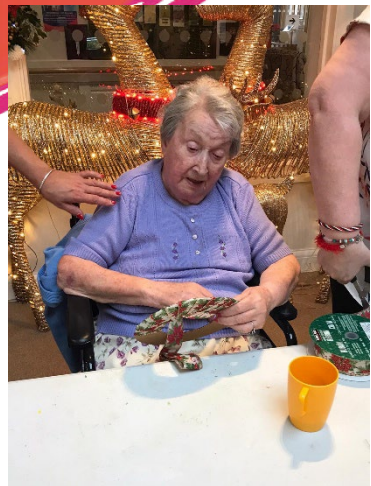
Filled with prayers and everyone joined in singing some Christmas Hymns.

Ministry Church Singing

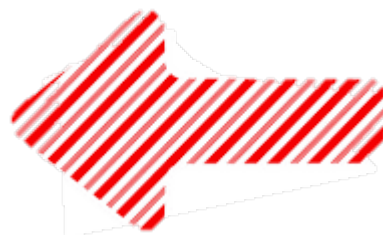


This month we had a visit from the Joyce Meyer Ministry who sang some lovely Christmas songs that all the residents loved listening to and singing along too.

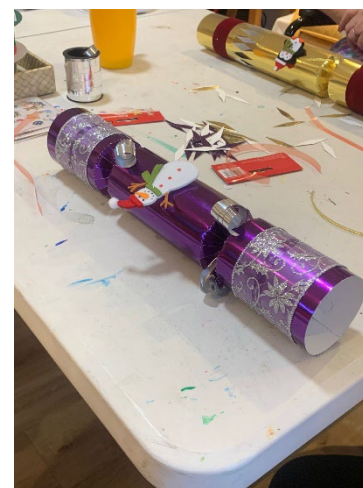

Staff enjoyed dressing up as elves for the day as you can see from the pictures!





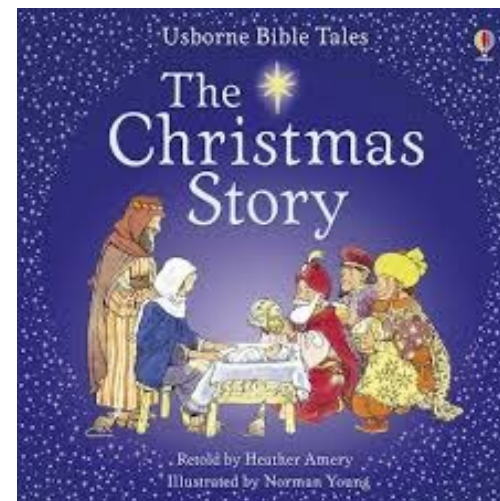
Pet Therapy – Marie and Barney

Pianist Paul

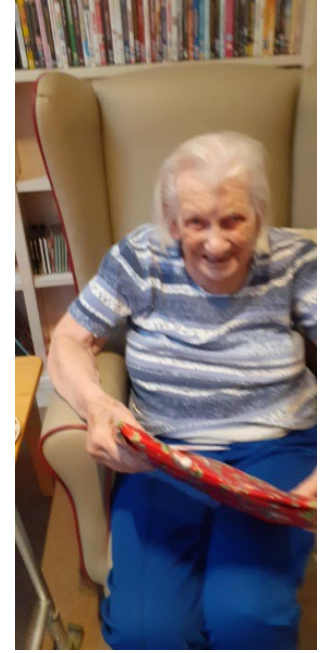


Paul the pianist came into entertain us and brought smiles to all the residents faces.
