Musical Memories with Gary Allen



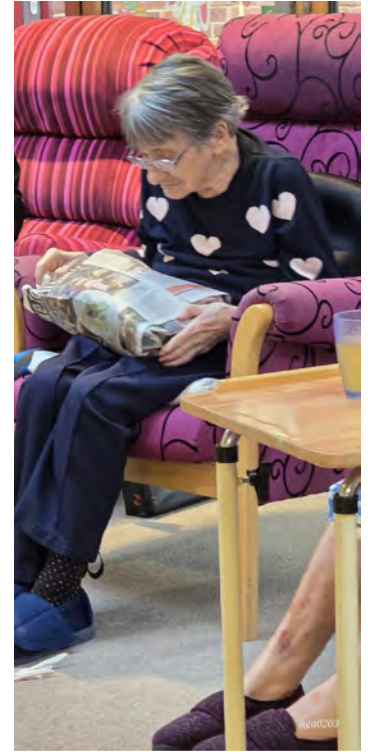
